Remember, taxes are due. How else can we continue to raid?


We will also be doing a good and toy drive again.


Welcome back to Bealidh Pursuivant's Corner!

So you have your name all ready to submit, right? Good because you cannot register a heraldic device without a name. Now let us work on your device. Historically and in the SCA, your device or arms is like your personal logo. Its purpose is to allow your friends, or even your enemies, to identify you from a distance. Since the main purpose was identification it became very important that no two people had the same arms registered. This is why the College of Arms came to be and why the SCA adopted our own College to ensure that each person have their own individual device.

A heraldic device is composed of different charges (objects, creatures, geometric shapes) arranged on a field (background). Good devices are simple yet memorable. They have easily identifiable charges and have high contrast-like street signs. You can begin by placing a few charges on a triangle-shaped shield. Then start by pick two colors (red, blue, green, black, and purple) and one metal (white/silver, yellow/gold) or fur (ermine, erminois, vair). Play around with the arrangement of the charges and the colors.

Once you have your idea get together with your herald, or drop by a "Heraldic Consultation Table" at any event which has one. (HINT- There will be one at 12th Night and one at Ursalmus!) After your herald has conflict checked your device to make sure it looks legal and unique, make sure **you** like it. Put it up on your refrigerator, or in your office, for a few weeks. If you're still as happy with it afterwards, mail it in or give it to the heralds to begin the process of "registering" it, so it can be uniquely yours in the SCA!



Old Business:

Autumn War – Big thanks to The Tribe everything was handled and no emergency vehicles came! It
was a real pleasure to do. Final count is either 1002 or 1020 will be counting one more time. Only
complaints were 2 people about walking to war field. We had one 30' road and the rest were 17' to
accommodate more camp space but it was noted that some people had a hard time driving around
the corners.

New Business:

- Lord Defenders/Last Chance site opens at 3pm; the site is paid for; 98 spots in hall to camp but things need to be removed by 9am; no longer accepting camping reservations; there is overflow parking 2 blocks up the road at the Longbranch Church --- please bring canned good item to donate to Church; 9 RV and quite a few large encampments have contacted us; Ellisif the deputy seneschal will be on-site. There is an issue with tall grass not being mowed. Arts and Sciences entries are needed. There will be Populace Arts and Sciences with 3 sections: youth, adult and laurel.
- Sergeant's Trials 1st weekend of October at the Swiss Sportsmen Club. Friday night will be stone soup and the candidates' written test. There will be rapier and heavy for all to come to. Saturday Night is a potluck Feast. HL Audny, Lady Zahra, and Baron Josef are the candidates. Close down Sunday.
- Harvest Feast: Pre-registration closes 15th with only 120 spaces so register early. Cost is \$25 plus NMS we are allowing off board for a different price. The men of the tribe are putting together a Middle Eastern cuisine/Persian.
- Castle vs Hay Bales: There was lively discussion on saving money on buying hay bales by resurrecting the castle. There is a trailer with no brakes that can be picked up in the same area as Lord Defenders will be. Some background was given (paraphrased here) there was a lack of people to maintain the castle, store it and transport it. It was agreed that we could put the call out to see if anyone would step forward. Another option is to rent the one Stromgard has.
